The Gonzaga Eagles, behind the one-two scoring punch of their senior guard tandem of Tyler Thornton and Cedric Lindsay pulled away from Dallas Jesuit in the second half of their opening round game in the Gonzaga D.C. Classic Basketball Tournament, winning by a score of 83-69. Lindsay led the way with 21 points and Thornton chipped in 18 as the Eagles turned up their

pressure defense to spur the running game and open up a double digit lead in the third quarter after Jesuit has come back from a ten point half-time deficit to tie the game. Chris Udofia led the way for the Rangers with 16 points and a strong inside presence. James Leinbaugh added (3) three pointers and totaled 15 points. While Gonzaga struggled at times in their half-court sets, center Ben Dickinson scored 12 points off the bench and combined with the strong first-half play of freshman forward Kris Jenkins, who had 11 points, the Eagles placed four players in double figures. Forward Kevin Hogan added three steals for Gonzaga. Gonzaga will face the Calvert Hall Cardinals in Friday's second round at 6:45PM at Gonzaga's CarmodyCenter., while Jesuit will face the Sidwell Friends Quakers in a consolation round game.
